2020 AHA Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) Provider Manual

Books will not be available for purchase the day of the class. Another helpful reference guide is the 2020 Handbook of Emergency Cardiovascular Care. The PALS Course is designed for providers who respond to emergencies in infants and children. These include personnel in emergency response, emergency medicine, intensive care and critical care units such as physicians, nurses, paramedics and others who need a PALS course completion card for job or other requirements.

Please plan to be on time, anyone arriving 15 minutes after the course start time will need to reschedule. Students are expected to attend and participate in the entire course. Because the PALS Provider Course covers extensive material

in a short time, you will need to prepare for the course in advance.

You should prepare for the course by doing the following:

- Review and understand the information in your PALS Provider Manual.
 Specifically: 1 and 2 rescuer child and infant CPR, Management of respiratory emergencies,
 Rhythm disturbances and electrical therapy, Vascular access, Resuscitation team concept,
 Cardiac, respiratory and shock case discussions and simulations and Systematic Approach to
 Pediatric Assessment
- Review BLS adult guidelines (can be found at https://www.cprconsultants.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/01/2020-BLSSummary.pdf) The resuscitation scenarios require that your BLS

skills and knowledge are current. You will be tested on Child and Infant 1- rescuer skills and AED skills during the PALS Provider Course.

Review and understand the PALS algorithms/flowcharts (see pg. 312 for algorithm pages and pg. 319 for flowchart pages).
